This will be discussed at the October Meeting.



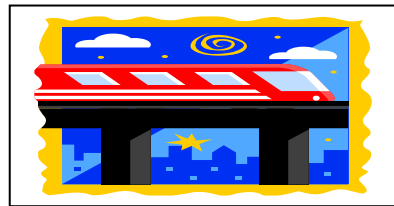
November 21, 2013 Meeting Election of Officers - Suggestions please!!!!
